Co-Mix Recycling Compactor - No Plastic Bags

■ Aluminum

Accepted: Aluminum beverage/food cans.

Not Accepted:

Pie plates and any cans contaminated with food.



■ Corrugated Cardboard

Accepted: Cardboard boxes.

Not Accepted: Plastic film, styrofoam, laminated coatings, or wet & food-soiled boxes. Preparation: Flatten to save space.

■ Magazines/Newspapers

Accepted: Magazines, catalogs, and clean dry newspaper with inserts.

■ Office Paper

Accepted: Copy paper, greeting cards, pamphlets, manila folders, mailings, junk mail, brochures, white envelopes with windows, and carbonless forms.

Not Accepted: Bright colored paper, brown kraft envelopes, chipboard, sticky labels, plastics, and shredded paper.

■ Telephone Books

Accepted: Used telephone books.



■ Plastics

Accepted: All plastic bottles with number 1 thru 7 inside "chasing arrow" symbol. Please remove lids and flatten to save space.

Not Accepted: Tubs are not accepted, even if labeled with 1 or 2, as well as containers contaminated with food, motor oil containers, and antifreeze containers.

■ Steel Cans

Accepted: All steel food cans. Test with magnet if unsure about material & please rinse.

Not Accepted: Cans contaminated with food.

Standard Recycling Containers

■ Mixed Glass

(Not mixed with other materials)

Accepted: Any color glass bottles & food jars.

Not Accepted: Light bulbs, crystal, or cookware.



■ Yard Waste

Accepted: Yard waste and limbs less than 8 feet long and 4 inches in diameter. 5'x8' truck bed sized load.

Not Accepted: Yard waste greater than above should be taken to the Maple Transfer Station off Airport Rd.

■ White Goods/Mixed Metals

Accepted: Old appliances such as air conditioners, washing machines, dryers and refrigerators.

Not Accepted: Television sets, stereos, and small kitchen appliances. No propane tanks.

■ Bulk Container

Accepted: Furniture Only

Not Accepted: Construction Waste

■ Other - See Attendant

Accepted: Dry Cell Batteries, Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs.

Automotive Products

■ Anti-Freeze

Accepted: Used anti-freeze from cars & other vehicles.

Not Accepted: Used anti-freeze contaminated with other material.

■ Lead Acid Batteries

Accepted: Batteries from cars and trucks.

Preparation: Store intact. If possible, exchange when purchasing new battery.

■ Motor Oil

Accepted: Used oil from cars and other vehicles, diesel fuel, transmission fluid, heating oil.

Not Accepted: Oil contaminated with antifreeze or other materials. No gasoline.

■ Used Oil Filters

Accepted

■ Tires

Accepted: Truck and car tires from personal vehicles.

Preparation: Tires must be taken off the rim and free of grease and mud.

■ Construction & Demolition Waste

Not Accepted: Construction Waste is accepted ONLY at the Maple Transfer Station.

Other Recycling Opportunities

■ Composting

Most food scraps, including coffee grounds, egg shells, and vegetables make good compost material. For additional information about composting and instructions on constructing composting cages, call the N.C. Cooperative Extension Service at 232-2261.

■ Rechargeable Batteries

Most rechargeable batteries must eventually be replaced. Alltel will accept phone batteries for recycling and Radio Shack can recycle your household rechargeable batteries.

■ Clothing and Housewares

Thrift stores in the area take many gently used items such as clothing and housewares. Call to see what they accept and whether they take deliveries. Some stores will pick up large items.

■ Eyeglasses

The Lions Club offers many drop-off points for clean, unbroken eyeglasses to be reused by others. Visit your local optical shop for more information.

■ Grocery Bags

Local grocery stores have containers for the collection of used paper and plastic grocery bags in front areas of their building.

■ Printer and Toner Cartridges

Used printer and toner cartridges can be recycled. For more information contact our office at 232-2504.

■ Shipping Peanuts

Most shipping companies can accept styrofoam shipping peanuts for reuse. Contact your local shipping offices for more info.
