



Do you know.....

Currituck County's recorded plats are online?

Plats recorded with the Register of deeds office can be found and printed from your home or office at <http://www.co.currituck.nc.us/Register-of-Deeds.cfm>. On the left side of the page under the Register of Deeds heading, choose ***Online Deed Search***. You must set up an account which is simply choosing a log on name and password. There is no cost to search for plats or deeds. The Register of Deeds simply likes to track how often their site is used. After your initial setup of your account you will have to log on to the site each time you visit.



There are two ways to search for the plat you need.

- **Name**: The name or title of the plat (i.e. Eagle Creek, Waterview Shores, or Carova)
- **Book/Page**: For when you already know the Book/Cabinet & Page/Slide Number (i.e. Map Book 4 Page 27 or Plat Cabinet H Slide 1)

NAME: You may search by person's name or by the name of a subdivision. When searching by the subdivision name, choose *Non Human* and type in the name like *RIVERSEEDGE*.

Book/Page:

Another method is to search for a **specific** plat cabinet and slide. This method requires that you know exactly where the plat is recorded. On the main **Search** page, choose to search by **Book and Page**. In the Book Page Search Menu Screen type the word “**PLAT**” in the **Book** field, and in the **Page** field, type in the slide or page# you are looking for. The search will take you to a page displaying all the plats recorded in the Register of Deeds under this slide/page number. You must then choose the book or cabinet that you are looking for.

If you don't know what the plat reference is you may try looking at the deed online first to see if the legal description tells you where the plat is recorded. Another way is to search for the parcel in the [County Online Interactive Maps](#). Sometimes the deed & plat references can be found there.

Note: The index type will default to “Consolidated Peal Property”. However, for plats recorded prior to 1995 the “Index Type” must be changed to “Real Estate.” If you do not find your plat on your first search, it is suggested that you change the index type and try again.
