### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to N.C. General Statutes Section 158-7.1 Currituck County, North Carolina proposes to appropriate and expend county funds for the following economic development project.

The Currituck County Board of Commissioners intends to consider entering into an economic development incentives contract with “Project Jessica.” Under the contract, the county will appropriate \$120,000.00 as a match for a State of North Carolina OneNC Fund economic development grant in like amount for the creation of corporate investment and creation of jobs within Currituck County. The Board of Commissioners believes this project will stimulate the economy and result in the creation of a substantial number of new, permanent jobs in the County.

The County will appropriate approximately \$91,000 in years one and two of the construction project from available county general fund revenue to construct a pump station, mains, bores as well as fund any engineering, materials and tap fees to complete “Project Jessica’s” connection to the Moyock Sewer System. The remaining \$29,000 will be provided as a cash grant, available in the third year of “Project Jessica’s” operations.

The Currituck County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on the county’s proposed appropriation and expenditure of funds for this project at 7:00 p.m. on January 21, 2014, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached, in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Currituck Historic Courthouse, 153 Courthouse Road, Currituck, North Carolina to receive comments from the public.
