# ELECTION AND CAMPAIGN SIGN REQUIREMENTS

The Currituck County Planning Department is soliciting your cooperation with the Unified Development Ordinance regulations as it pertains to Elections and Campaign Signs. Please be advised that under Chapter 5 of the Unified Development Ordinance the following regulations are in effect:

1. Signs shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet in surface area.
2. Signs shall not be located within the site distance triangle of 10'x70' at any public street right of way intersection. Further, no signs shall be located within the site distance triangle of 20'x20' at a point where driveways and private roads intersect with public and private road right of ways.
3. Signs that revolve or are animated or that utilize movement or apparent movement to attract attention of the public are prohibited, (i.e. banners, streamers, pennants, and flags.)
4. Signs shall not be attached to traffic signs, utility poles, structures, or trees.
5. Freestanding signs shall be adequately secured and stabilized.
6. Signs shall not be located on vehicles or trailers that are not currently licensed and registered by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
7. No signs permitted on county property (county policy)
8. **All signs shall be removed within ten (10) days following the election or conclusion of the campaign.**
