We regret that you have suffered an injury on the job that may result in your need to seek medical care and/or cause you to miss work. Our worker's compensation program is designed to make sure that you receive the best care possible and that your needs are met promptly.

After your initial injury exam, you must receive written permission to change physicians from the Industrial Commission **before** any treatment is rendered by another physician. Currently, our Claims Management service is:

We suggest that you go to [Cigna.com](http://Cigna.com) and search for a provider that is in our network, to prevent instances of additional out of network costs to you, should your claim be denied by the Industrial Commission.

For non-emergency injuries, we suggest that you go to your In-network health provider or an urgent care center. Please see the list that is in this packet. However, all follow-up care should be redirected to Sedgwick CMS at the address and number above.
