

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


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Youth Athletics

Spring/Fall Soccer

Players learn basic soccer skills and coordination, as well as team sportsmanship.

Ages: 5-6, 7-9, 10-12 (co-ed). Must be age 5 before September 1.

Fee: \$20 per child/\$40 maximum per family.

Spring Registration: January-February,

Fall Registration: June-July



T-Ball

T-Ball is a baseball program involving instruction and competition for boys and girls. Ages 4-6. Must be 4 by May 1.

Fee: \$25 per child/\$50 maximum per family.

Registration: February-March. Birth certificate is required for new players.



Rookie League Baseball/Softball

Ages 7-8. Boys must be age 7 by May 1 of the current year. Girls must be 7 by December 31 of the previous year.

Fee: \$25 per child/\$50 maximum per family.

Registration: February-March

Youth Baseball

Players learn hand-eye coordination, as well as baseball skills and team sportsmanship.

Ages: 9-10, 11-12, 13-15

Fee: \$25 per child/\$50 maximum per family.

Registration: February-March



Girls Fast Pitch Softball

Players learn coordination, softball skills and good sportsmanship.

Ages: 9-10, 11-12, 13-16. Softball age deadline is December 31 of previous year.

Fee: \$25 per child/\$50 maximum per family.

Registration: February-March



Junior Tennis Program

All participants will learn basic strokes, how to keep score, tennis etiquette and other beginning skills.

Intermediate and advanced players will receive instruction based upon individual needs.

Ages: Children - Teenagers. Must have completed Kindergarten to be eligible.

Fee: \$45 per student.

Registration: May

Girls Spring/Fall Volleyball

Participants learn basic volleyball skills.

Ages: 8-10, 11-13 Must be 8 by September 1.

Fee: \$20 per child/\$40 maximum per family.

Registration: January-February (Spring) and June-July (Fall)



Tackle Football

Participants play in Albemarle area leagues. Workout sessions are required. Players on a school team are ineligible to participate.

Ages 7-8 (120 lb. max) Must be 7 by August 1.

Ages 9-10 (160 lb. max)

Ages 11-12 (185 lb. max), must not have turned 13 before August 1 of current year.

Fee: \$25 per child.

Registration: June-July



Flag Football/Cheerleading

Learn fundamental flag football skills or cheers and pom-pom routines.

Ages: 5-6, 7-9, 10-12. Players must have reached age 5 prior to August 1 and not reached age 13 prior to August 1 of the current year.

Fee: \$20 per child/\$40 maximum per family.

Registration: September-October

Youth Basketball

Players learn basic principles of the game, fundamentals and strategies.

Ages: 5-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15 (Boys/Girls)

Players must be age 5 by January 1 of the current year.

Fee: \$20 per child/\$40 maximum per family.

Registration: November



Adult Athletics

Adult Basketball

Teams will be comprised of individuals age 18 and older.

Fee: \$150 per team

Registration: February

Adult Softball

Registration is available for Men's and Women's leagues. Participants must be ages 16 and older.

Fee: \$200 per team

Registration: April-May

Special Olympics

Bowling, Basketball and Volleyball

These programs are available for Special Olympic athletes and are sponsored by Currituck County Parks and Recreation.

Participants are eligible for state-level competitions and must be ages 8 and up.
