

**Stormwater Advisory Board**  
**Minutes**  
**July 17, 2007 – 7:00 p.m.**  
**Historic Courthouse (Board of Commissioners room)**

The Stormwater Advisory Board held a meeting July 17, 2007, 7:00 p.m. in the Historic Courthouse, Currituck, NC. Board members present: Jerry Old, Wade Morgan, Finley Newbern, Harold Capps. Mike Doxey (Currituck SWCD) and Eric Weatherly (County Engineer) were also present.

Elected officers are as follows: Jerry Old, Chairman; Don Cheek, Vice-Chairman; \*Finley Newbern\*, Secretary.

Items discussed:

- Get a recorder so we don't take notes, get Kim to type them up.
- Meet every third Thursday of every other month, Mike will call everybody on the second Thursday to remind them of meeting, next meeting is September 25 – 7:00 p.m.
- Concerns of the group – protection of drainage as we grow from agriculture to residential, regulation of drainage in minor subdivisions, draft a new Stormwater ordinance (look at Pasquotank County's).
- Concerns of Jerry: develop and outline first, prioritize, alleviate flooding, residential and agricultural, proper engineered drainage plans, stricter rules, and charge permit fee for stormwater improvements.
- Concerns of Harold: work on the fill issue, manpower to enforce.
- Concerns of Wade: drainage in general is important, master plan should be flexible.
- Mike is going to get Dwane Hinson to come to the next meeting (September 25).
- Determine how the other counties came up with their objectives.
- Develop our own objectives.
- Discussed options for money, countywide tax versus pockets of different taxes, did not come to a consensus.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
