

**STORMATER ADVISORY BOARD MEETING  
MINUTES  
THURSDAY, DECEMBER 11, 2008  
7:00 P.M  
HISTORIC COURTHOUSE, CURRITUCK, NC**

The Stormwater Advisory Board held a public meeting, Thursday, December 11, 2008 in the Historic Courthouse. Members present were Wade Morgan, Charlie Dozier and Harold Capps. Jerry Old and Don Cheek were absent. Secretary Charlie Dozier called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Eric Weatherly, (County Engineer), Mike Doxey and Kim Ferrell (Soil & Water Conservation) were also present.

**Approval of July 17, 2008 minutes** – Motion was made by Wade Morgan to approve minutes as presented. Motion was seconded by Harold Capps. Motion passed unanimously.

**County Stormwater Ordinance** – Mike Doxey gave a brief update of status of the stormwater ordinance. PHR & A Engineering Firm was approved to begin work on the stormwater ordinance. The Planning Department recently reviewed it and would like to see more engineered drawings and diagrams as per Ben Woody, Planning Director. Planning would like to see more water quality issues addressed. Mr. Doxey and Mr. Weatherly do not agree with these changes, they would recommend proceeding as is with the ordinance and will talk with Ben Woody and Dan Scanlon concerning these issues. These changes as quoted by PHR & A would up the cost to approximately \$39,000.00 instead of the original \$32,000.00. Another issue would be where to get the additional \$7,000.00 to pay for changes to the ordinance. Mr. Doxey added that Pasquotank is getting ready to approve their drainage ordinance, which was also prepared by PHR & A. Mr. Doxey also added that with the proposed drainage ordinance, the \$32,000.00 would include trainings on computer software and this would set the standard for everything else that was presented.

Mr. Morgan asked what type of water quality issues would the ordinance address?

Mr. Weatherly stated that would include holding ponds and constructed wetlands.

**Swains Lane Drainage Project** – Mr. Doxey gave an update on the project stating that Swains Lane consists of a 3,000 foot drainage ditch that needs to be cleaned out. Gary Cartwright gave a proposal of \$17,000 - \$22,000 to clean it out. Bid packets were sent out to several contractors, Roland Richards Excavating was awarded the bid for \$3,500.00. This project is not a county project; it will have to be paid for by the landowners. Mike Doxey will talk with the landowners and see if project can be funded.

**Old Business** – Eric Weatherly stated they thought the drainage plan for whalehead subdivision had been approved but CAMA has claimed jurisdiction on one of the outlets

and the project is on hold for now. County is trying to get access to another pond owned by Bob DeGabrielle and are trying to contact him concerning the project.

Mike Doxey gave an update for Moyock Service District, stating PHR & A has agreed to do a survey and inventory of all ditches and culverts for approximately \$17,000.00.

New Business – no new business was discussed.

**Next meeting will be held Thursday, March 19, 2009 at 7:00 pm, Historic Courthouse conference room.**

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
