Dear Volunteer Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in becoming a volunteer with the Currituck County 4-H Program. Enclosed is a copy of the volunteer application which must be completed in full before you can begin your volunteer service. With this application, you must complete three references. References must not include family members.

After your complete application and references are turned in, we will start by having your criminal/driving history checked. According to the findings, we will then make the determination whether to accept or deny your application. This is a routine process conducted for all prospective 4-H volunteers and is simply a means of making 4-H safe for our youth.

Upon acceptance of your application, you must then complete approximately three hours of orientation with a 4-H staff person. At that time, you will be given all materials necessary to carry out your volunteer responsibilities. Two additional trainings will be required annually. You will be expected to be an active member of the county 4-H leader's Association and keep routine contact with the 4-H staff to provide us monthly records including membership & enrollment, financial reports, time sheets, contact hours and 4-H member participation reports.
