



NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION CURRITUCK COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

A primary election will be held on Tuesday, April 30, 2019 in Currituck County.

Polls will be open from 6:30 AM to 7:30 PM on the day of the election, Tuesday, April 30, 2019. One-stop early voting will be held at the Currituck County Board of Elections office, **2811 Caratoke Hwy, Currituck, NC 27929**. One-stop early voting will be open from 7:00 AM Wednesday, April 10 until 7:00 PM Friday, April 26. The hours are as follows: **April 10-April 26, Monday-Friday, 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM. April 13 and April 20, 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM**. Canvass will be held in the Currituck County Board of Elections office at 11:00 AM on Friday, May 10, 2019.

Absentee voting by mail is available. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made on an absentee request form (available at ncsbe.gov and at the county board of elections office), and must be returned to the Currituck County Board of Elections office by Tuesday, April 23, 2019, 5:00 PM. Absentee voting requires the voter to complete an application on the return envelope that must be witnessed by two qualified persons **or** a notary public. Completed absentee ballots must be returned to the Board of Elections by 5:00 PM on Election Day (ballots received by mail after this time will be considered timely if they are received by May 3, 2019 and postmarked on or before Election Day). Voters may receive assistance voting a mail-in absentee ballot from a qualified person of their choice.

All persons who are registered to vote with Currituck County may vote in this election. Persons who are **not** already registered to vote in the county must register by Friday, April 5, 2019 to be eligible to vote in this election. **Voters who are not registered in the county by that deadline** may register and vote during one stop early voting only, and will be required to provide documentation of their identity and residence. **Voters who wish to change party affiliation** or who have changed name or address must do so by the registration deadline. Because this is a Primary Election, voters will be required to vote the ballot of the party they are registered as. Unaffiliated voters may choose their ballot when they present to vote. To check your voter registration, please visit www.ncsbe.gov or call the Board of Elections office.

Voters appearing to vote in person are entitled to assistance by an election official, or, if assistance is needed due to disability or illiteracy, by a qualified person of their choice. Voting sites are accessible to all voters. Curbside voting is available for voters who are not able to enter voting sites.
